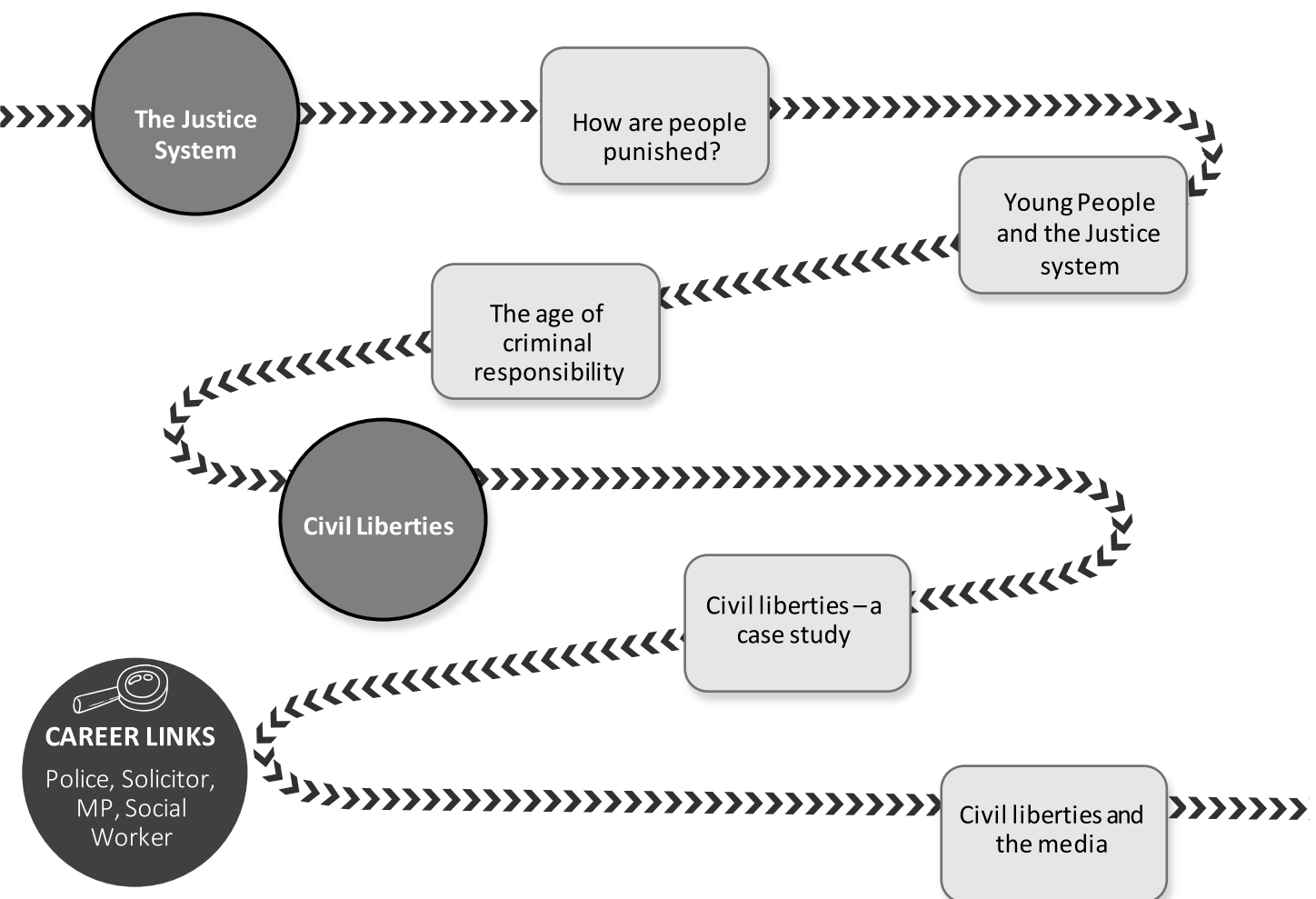

Rights, Justice and the Law

Year 8 Spring Term 2

This term we continue with our topic on Rights, Justice and the Law. We will find out how the criminal justice is applied to young people. This is an important topic as you need to understand how the law impacts you. We will finish this topic by considering civil liberties and what this means in relation to the media. We will develop our debating skills as we consider the age of legal responsibility and develop our understanding of the Tudor Learning and Character Habits as we focus on being **curious** and **analytical**, and demonstrating **respect** and **responsibility**.



Tudor Value –Respect (for the law) – To ensure we follow the law so our actions do not have a negative impact on others
