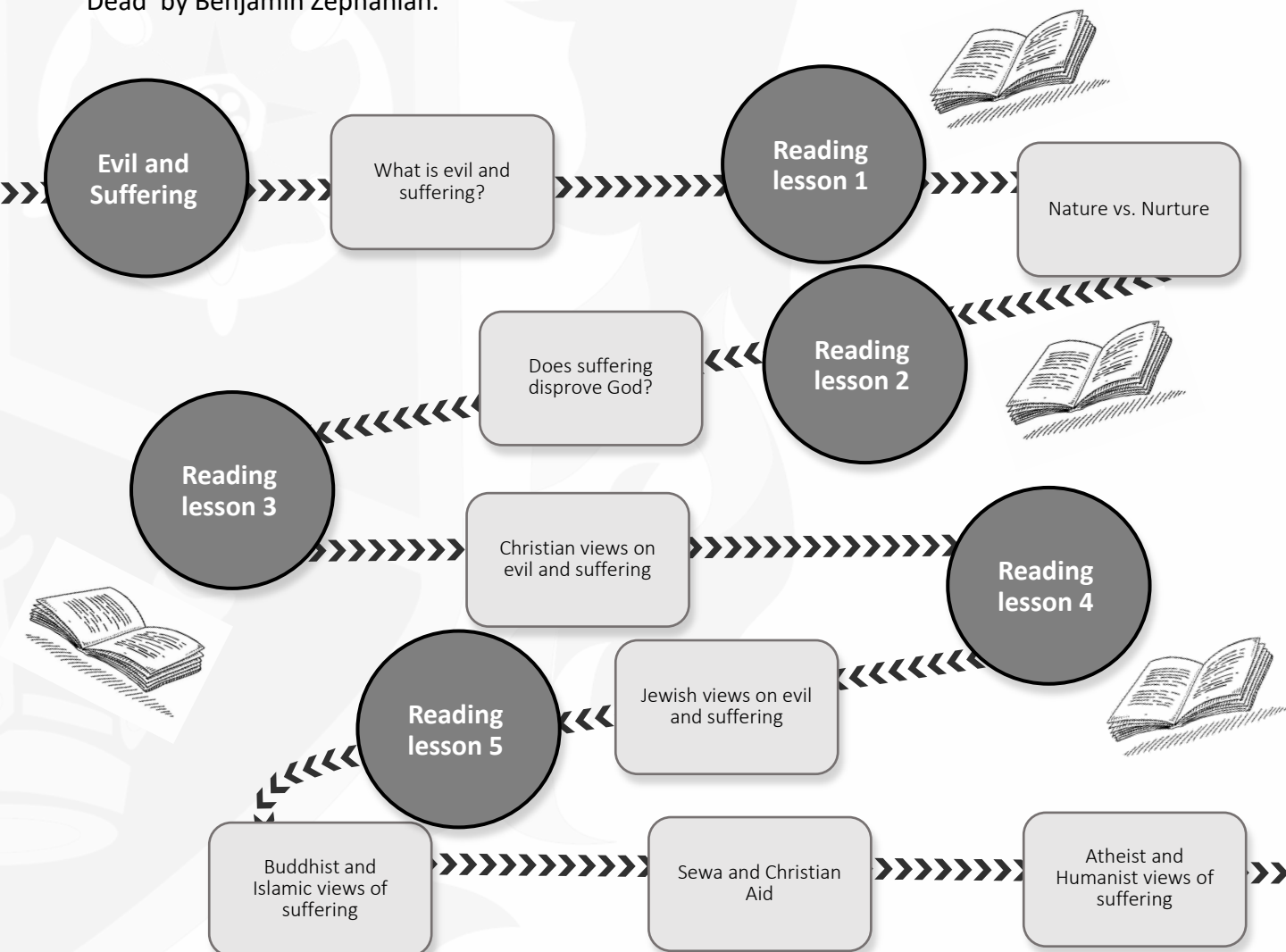


LEARNING JOURNEY



Year 8 Spring Term – Why is there Evil and Suffering?

This term, we will be focussing on understanding what is meant by the terms 'evil and suffering'. We also will be looking at the differences between natural and moral evil and nature vs. nurture. We will then look at what it means to be 'good' and the different situations / variables that lead to moral or immoral behaviour as well as an examination of whether or not evil and suffering disprove the existence of God. We will achieve this through a study of a key text called 'Teacher's Dead' by Benjamin Zephaniah.
