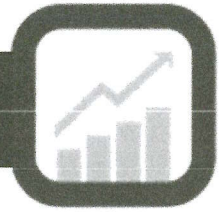

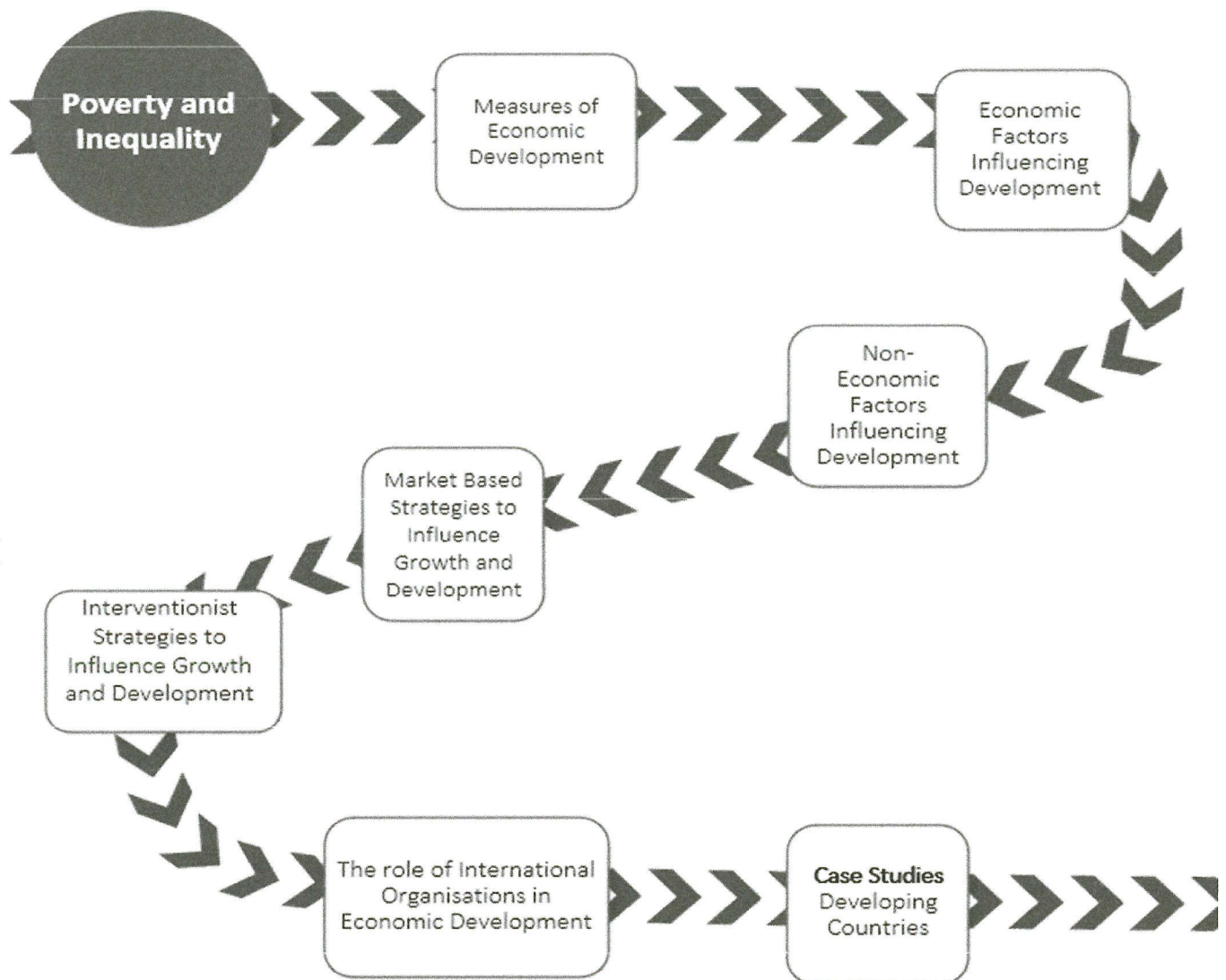
Economics
