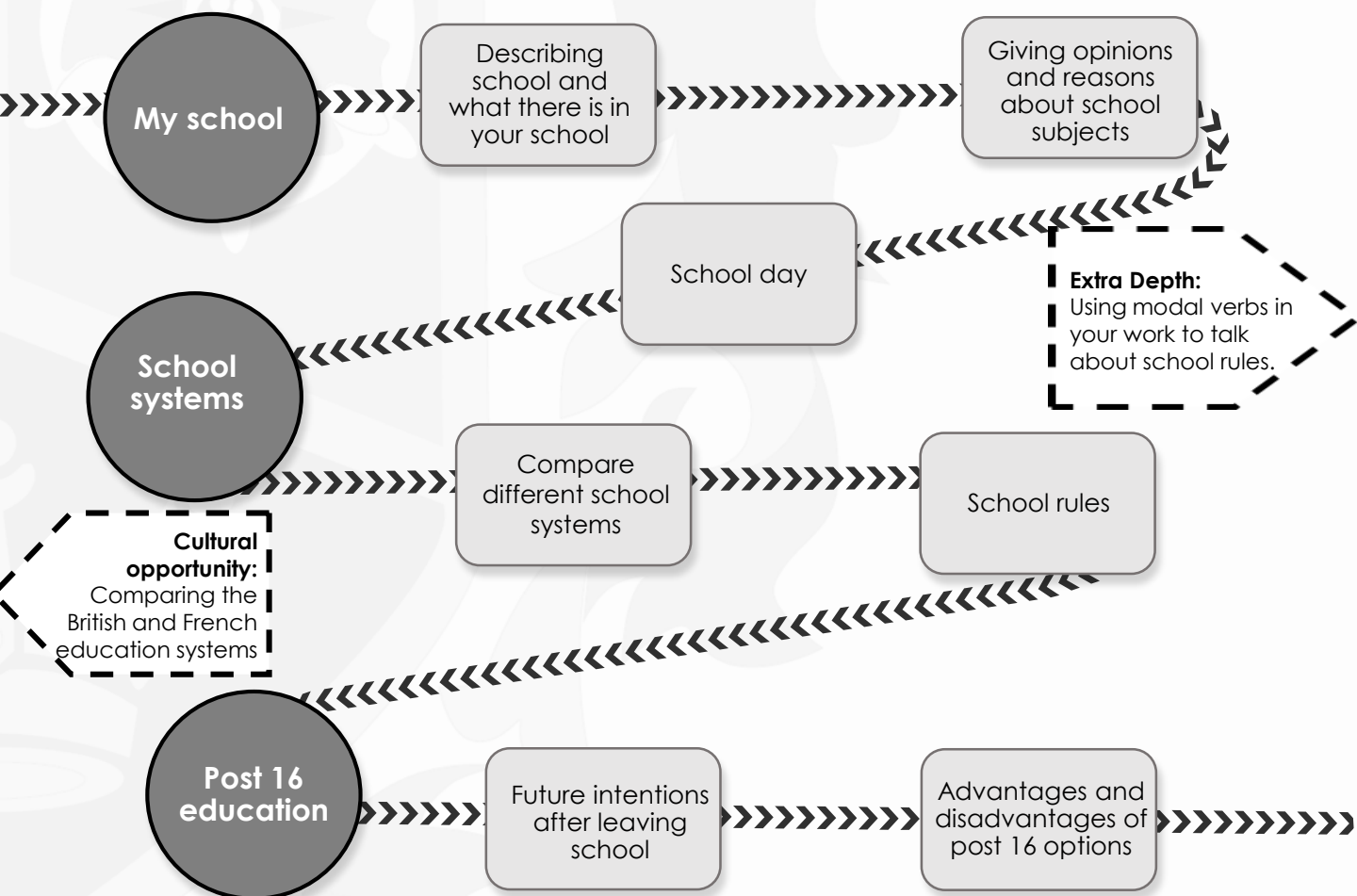

Year 10: Le collège (School)

Spring Term 2

During Spring 2, you will use the vocabulary learnt in the year 9 topic of School to give reasoned opinions about your school subjects and your school day. You will learn about the key differences between going to school in Britain and going to school in a French speaking country. You will boost your cultural capital by comparing the differences between a typical school day in France and in England. You will draw upon prior knowledge to also discuss your opinions of the school rules and school uniform. You will be reusing the 'il faut' structure, initially learnt in the year 9 topic of healthy living to say what you must and mustn't do at school. You will also revisit the proper future tense and conditional mood to say what you intend to do for you post 16 choices.



TUDOR HABITS: As we discuss school and school rules, you will need to be **reflective** and **analytical** when engaging with some familiar vocabulary and consolidating grammar structures.
