


Les vacances (Holidays)

Year 10 Summer Term

During Summer term, you will reuse the vocabulary learnt in the year 9 topic of holidays to give reasoned opinions about your normal holidays trips and the activities you like to do whilst away. You will learn how to order food in a restaurant, make holiday arrangements and ask for tourist information. This is essential exam skill practice, as your GCSE speaking exams may include a roleplay on situations such as these. You will boost your cultural capital by looking at francophone tourist destinations. You will revise past, present and future tenses to discuss past disaster holidays and future ideal ones. This will also require use of prior knowledge as you revisit key vocabulary from the year 9 topic of holidays where you learnt to describe past negative experiences and to use the conditional tense to talk about places you would like to visit.
