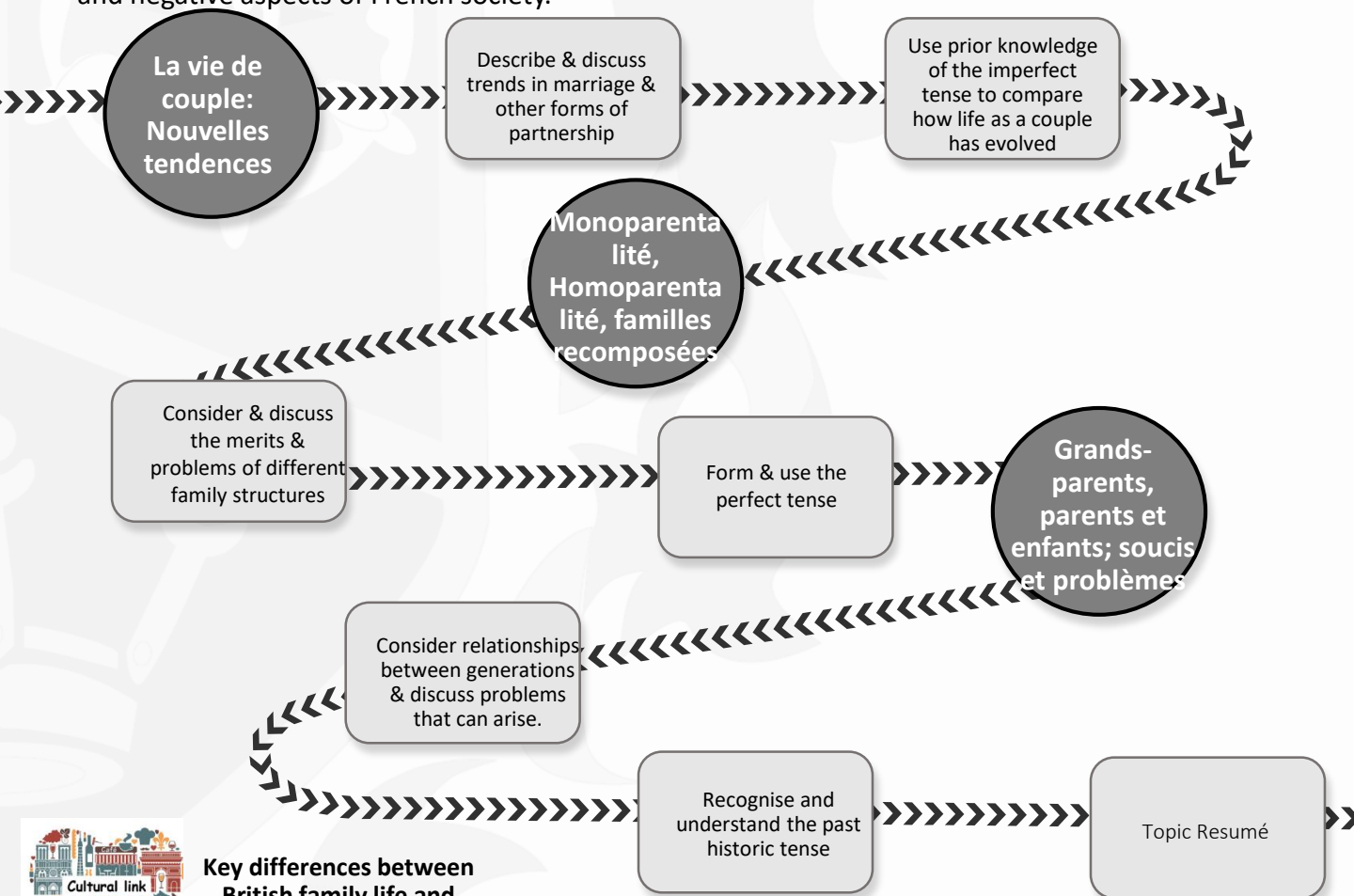


# LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

You will be able to refer to the vocabulary learnt in this topic and use it throughout your A-Level, including key dates, cultural understanding and the ability to talk about positive and negative aspects of French society.
