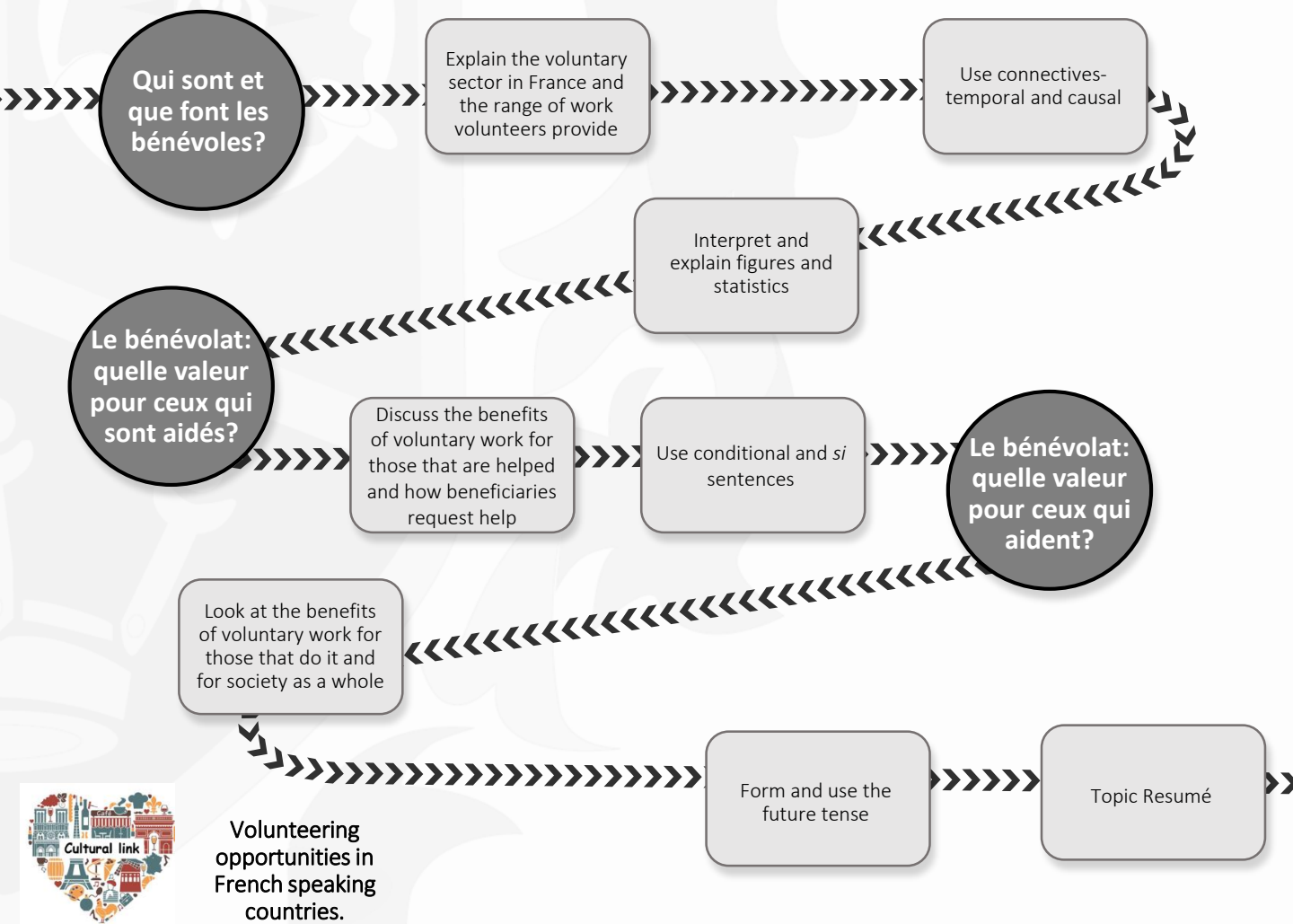


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

Le rôle du bénévolat (the role of the voluntary sector)

In Year 11 we covered social and global issues, in which we learnt to discuss actions in the community in past and future tenses. You can now develop on this by transforming your discussions from a personal narrative, to a more analytical and evaluative exploration of how volunteering is perceived in francophone countries, as well as revising the future tense and the conditional in the complex sentences with *si*. By the end of this topic you will be able to refer to volunteering case studies in French-speaking countries with statistics to support your argument. This will allow you to discuss pros and cons of the voluntary sector. This topic provides a good introduction to critical analysis, which is a key skill at French A-Level.
