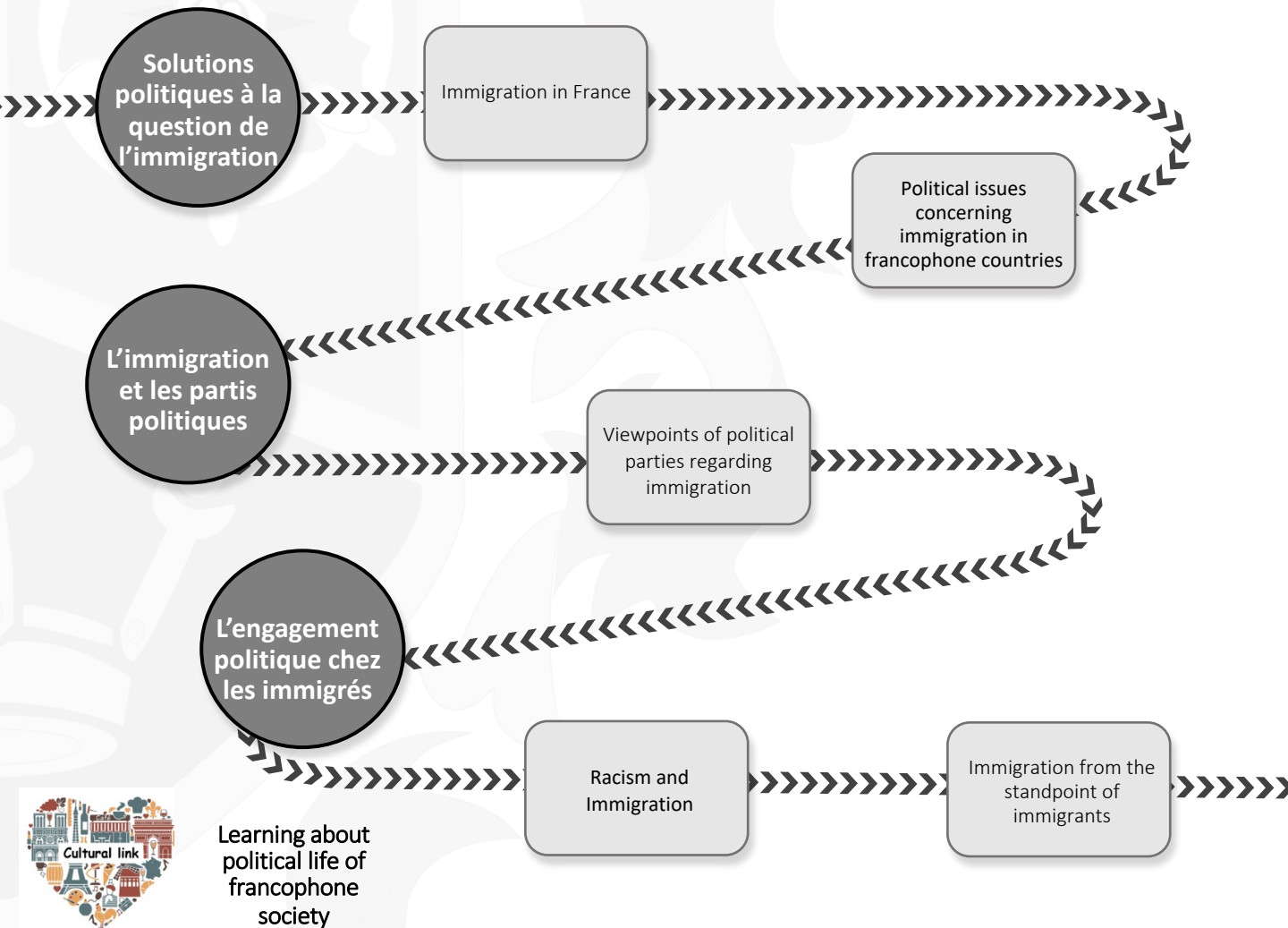


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

L'immigration (Immigration)

Year 13 Spring Term 2

This half term you will learn about some of the political issues concerning immigration in French speaking countries and consider immigration from the point of view of immigrants. You will discuss the different attitudes towards immigration by political parties in francophone countries. The topic is linked with the topic of political engagement and political parties that you learnt during Autumn term 2. You will study immigration in the context of racism and this will bring you back to the topic of tolerance and diversity that you learnt in Autumn term 1, as well as the topic of marginalisation covered during Autumn term 2. Some of you may have studied the problems of racism and charity organisations that help fighting with racism (SOS Racisme) in Year 11 when learning about social and global issues.
