

Year 7: La ville et les passe-temps (Town and Free time activities)

Spring Term 2 - Summer Term 1

In primary school you may have acquired some basic French knowledge of the topic of places in town and free time activities. The current topic will allow you to describe your town in French, in particular to say what there is and isn't in your town and also what places you can visit in your town. In order to talk about what you can do in your town, you will learn modal verbs in French (vouloir = to want and pouvoir = to be able to). You will also learn the conjugation of the verbs vouloir and pouvoir (the concept of conjugation was introduced to you in Spring term 1). In Autumn term 2 you were introduced to the opinion verbs and some adjectives. You will use and extend this knowledge when expressing opinions with justifications about activities you can do in town. In this topic you will also develop your understanding of the verbs jouer = to play and faire = to do. When describing where you can go in your town, you will use the structure à (to) + the definite article (the).



TUDOR HABITS: As we increase the amount of vocabulary and grammar that we learn, you will need to show your grit and **resilience** when the work is getting more difficult as well as demonstrate a **systematic** approach when learning new vocabulary. During pair or group work, for example when asking and giving directions, show your **creativity** by adding to discussions and sharing what you have learnt.
