Les vacances (Holidays)

Summer Term 2

In primary school you may have acquired some basic French knowledge of the topic of holidays. The current topic will allow you to describe your holidays in French, in particular to say where you go on holidays, what activities you do and to talk about your future holidays. In Spring term 2 and Summer term 1 you were introduced to the vocabulary of free time activities. You will use and extend this knowledge when talking about your holiday activities. To talk about your future holidays, you will use the Near Future tense. To describe your ideal holidays, you will use the structure *je voudrais* (*I would like*). You will also learn the numbers up to 100 in French, building on what you learnt in Autumn term 1 where you were introduced to numbers from 1 to 30. In this topic you will also develop further your understanding of the prepositions in French (building on your knowledge from Spring term 2 and Summer term 1).
