
## LEARNING JOURNEY French

Les Fêtes (Celebrations and festivals)

## Year 8 Summer Term 2

During Summer 1, you will learn to describe your favourite celebrations and discover some of the more famous francophone traditions such as La Galette des Rois. You will also be drawing upon the vocabulary learnt in the year 8 spring term topic of identity and relationships to talk about what you like to wear to parties. You will be re-using your knowledge of modal verbs, which you studied in the year 7 topic of town and re-visited this year in spring 1 to talk about your local area. This half-term, you will use modal verbs to describe organising a party. Furthermore, your knowledge of forming comparatives will be required, which you re-visited in the spring term to compare different type of houses. Here, comparatives will allow you to compare different types of celebrations. You will need to be able to use the three main tenses (past, present and future) to talk about recent and future celebratory events.



**TUDOR HABITS:** You will be developing your empathy and kindness as you learn about the religious and secular festivals of other cultures. You will also have to be reflective as we use existing knowledge in a new context.
