

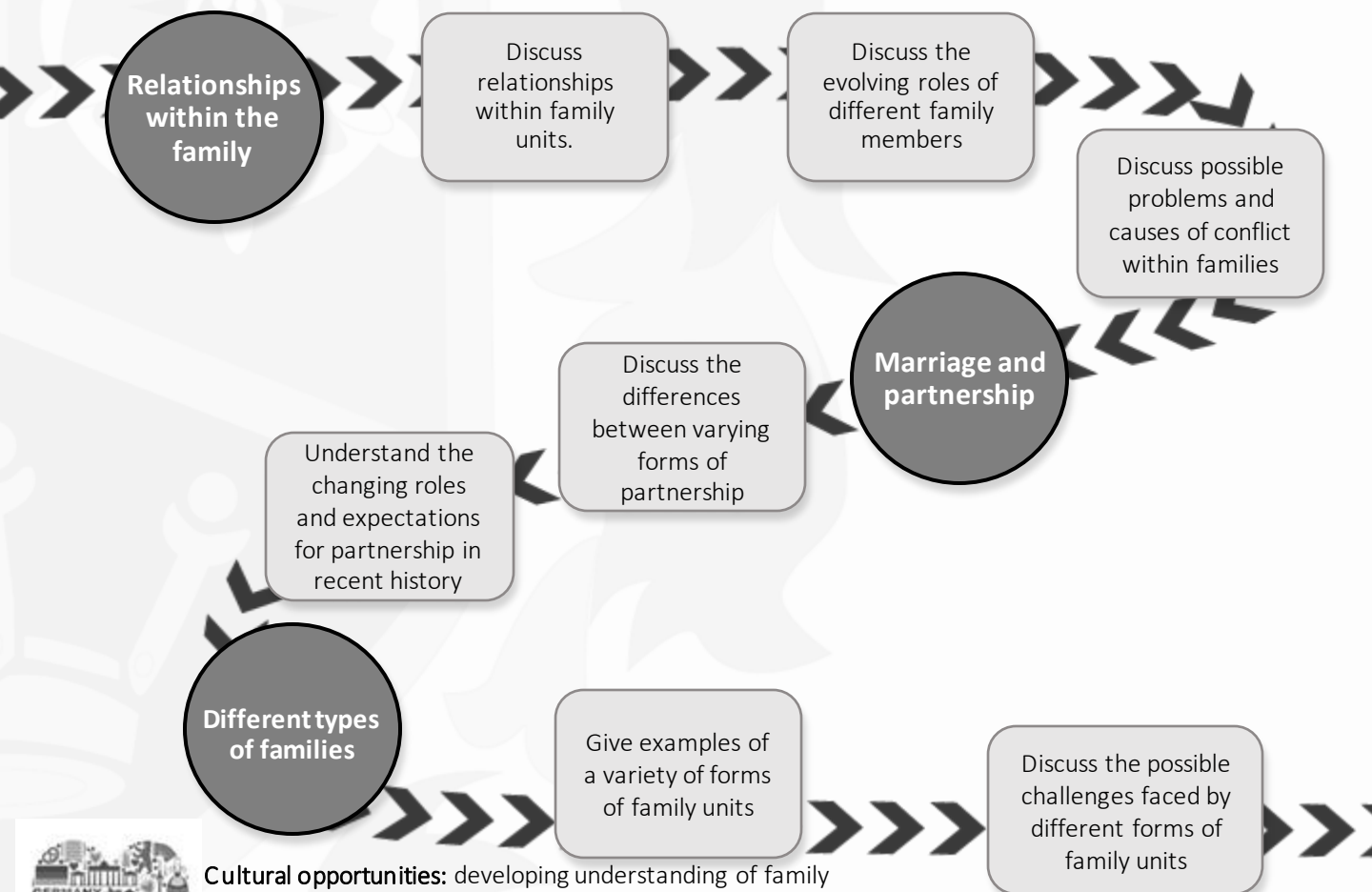

The topic of family is something that we will be very familiar with from our study of German. From giving basic descriptions of family members in Year 7, to discussing our relationships with family members and the pros and cons of marriage at GCSE, there is lots of prior knowledge that we can draw on to support our understanding of this topic. Within this unit of work, we will go beyond our personal experiences and start to examine the topic of family from a more objective perspective. We will consider changes and developments in society and in societal expectations, as well as investigate other aspects of this topic that may go beyond our own lived experiences e.g. divorce, LGBTQ+ families and multigenerational families.



Cultural opportunities: developing understanding of family life in German-speaking countries, statistics relating to marriage, divorce and different types of family units, learning about German wedding traditions.
