

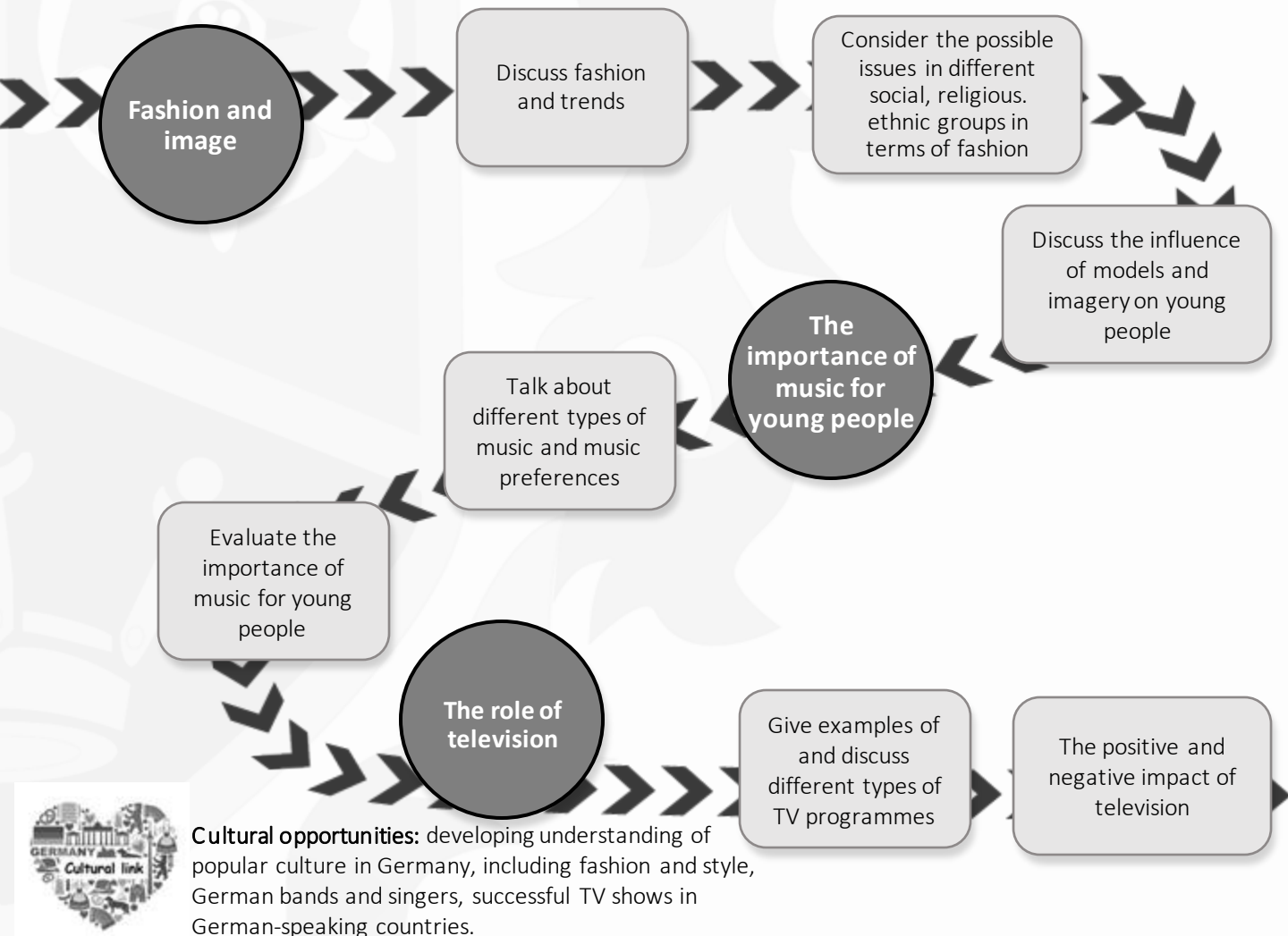

This topic on youth culture will expose you to a plethora of influences on contemporary target language society. By examining fashion, music and television through a more analytical lens than in the GCSE topic of free time, you will develop your knowledge of German-speaking singers, bands and actors, as well as enriching your understanding of modern life for young people in DACH countries. In addition to discussing your own personal preferences, and those of young people in German-speaking countries, we will also consider these concepts more critically. For example, we will investigate the influence that these aspects of culture have on young people today and ascertain to what extent this influence is positive or negative. Themes studied within this unit are also popular choices for IRP titles in Year 13, where you can explore one element in much more detail.
