

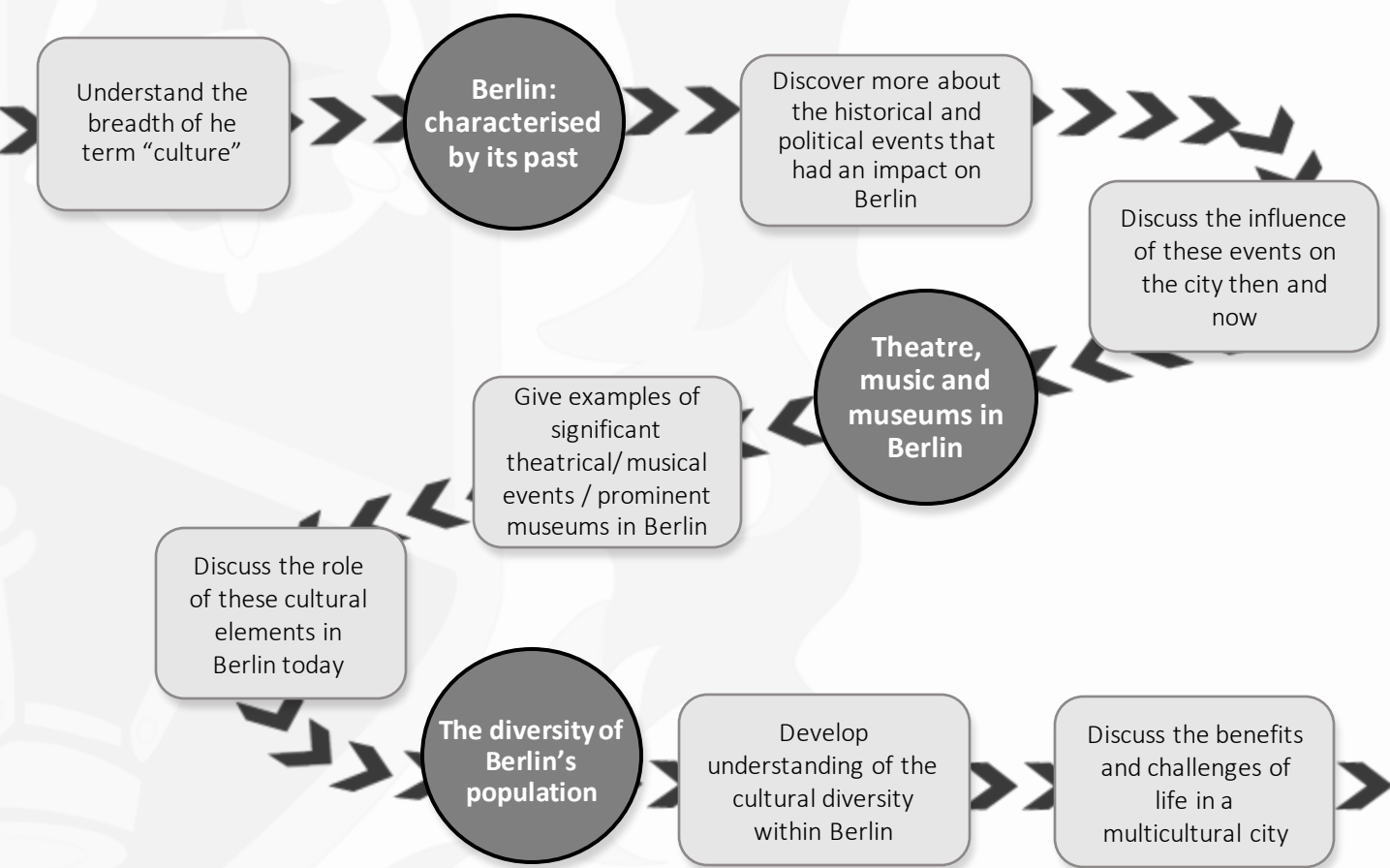

Year 12 Summer

This unit of work acts as a bridge between Year 12 and Year 13 study. You will develop your understanding of the socio-historic context of the film you have studied (*Good-bye Lenin!*), and towards the end of the unit you will start to explore topics such as multiculturalism, which are studied in more profound detail during the Year 13 course. This unit also offers a wealth of opportunities to enhance and develop your cultural understanding of a variety of different aspects (literature, history, theatre, music, museums, diversity), and therefore may act as a springboard for ideas for your Independent Research Project (IRP).



Cultural opportunities: developing a profound understanding of a variety of cultural aspects within the capital city of Berlin. This entire unit allows you to explore culture more deeply.

TUDOR HABITS: Throughout the unit we will reflect on our definition of culture, and which varied aspects of life make up our culture. You will need to be open-minded as we challenge your existing ideas and preconceptions, as well as broadening your intercultural understanding.
