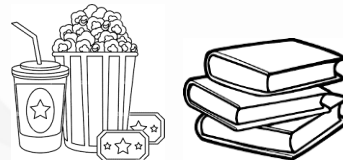

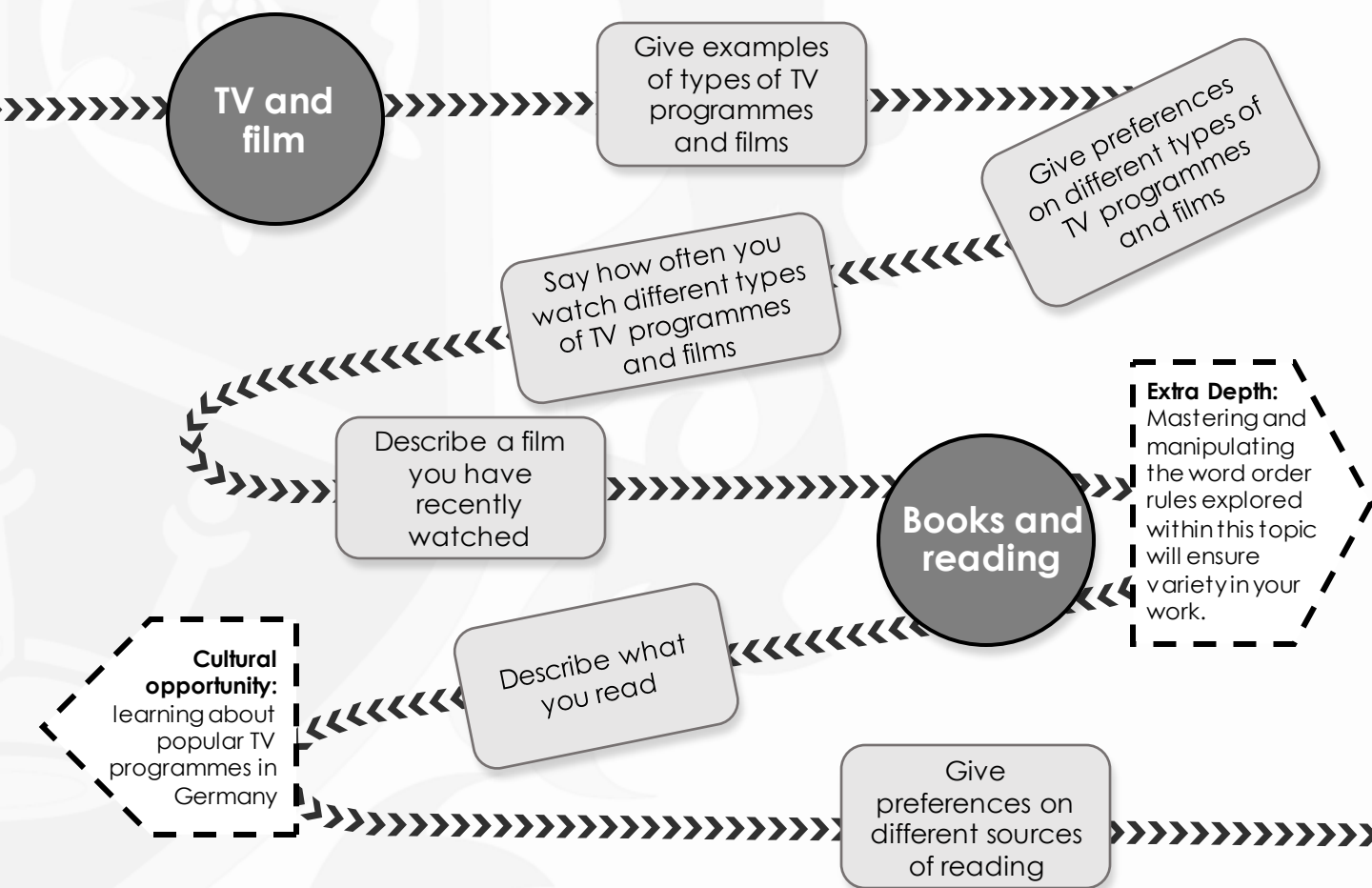

Year 8: Die Medien (Media)

Spring term 2

This half term you will begin our media topic, learning a range of vocabulary to **discuss and give opinions on different types of films, TV programmes and books**. You will discuss your habits and **say how often you use different types of media**. You will also revisit and extend your knowledge of the **structures used to give preferences**, which you learnt in Year 7, to say which forms of media you **like, prefer and like best of all**. You will learn a range of topic-specific adjectives and phrases, to enable you to **give more specific, developed reasons for your opinions**. You will also **continue to develop your understanding and use of different tenses**, consolidating the work that you have done so far on the perfect tense in Spring 1 and the future tense in Autumn 1.



TUDOR HABITS:

This unit of work requires you to **be precise and analytical**, as we develop and extend your use of different structures to give preferences. The word order is very prescriptive for these phrases. Therefore, you will need to pay close attention to the rules and conventions of this aspect of grammar.
