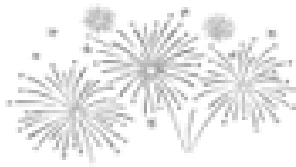


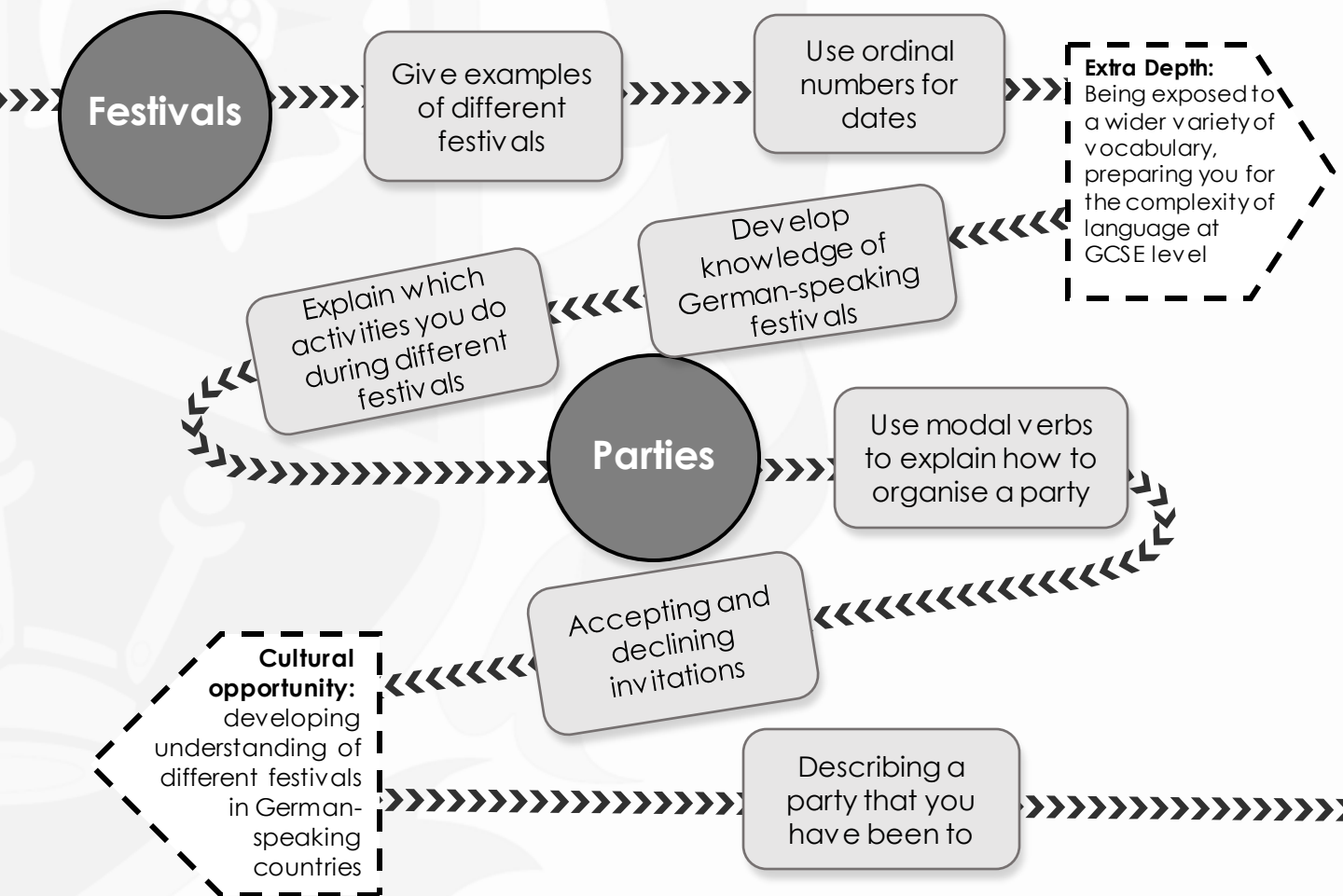

Year 9: Feste (Customs and Festivals)

Spring Term 2 and Summer Term 1

This unit of work acts as a bridge between KS3 and GCSE study. Before progressing to KS4, you will have further opportunity to **consolidate key fundamentals** such as **modal verbs and the perfect tense** (past tense), as well as extend your grammatical awareness further through learning more about the **imperfect tense**. Moreover, this is a more challenging topic in terms of the **range of vocabulary** that you are required to use. Being exposed to this wider variety of vocabulary will prepare you for GCSE study, where the **breadth and complexity of language** that you are required to understand increases further. There is also an emphasis on **enhancing your cultural understanding** within this topic, which **supports your personal development and builds your cultural capital**.
