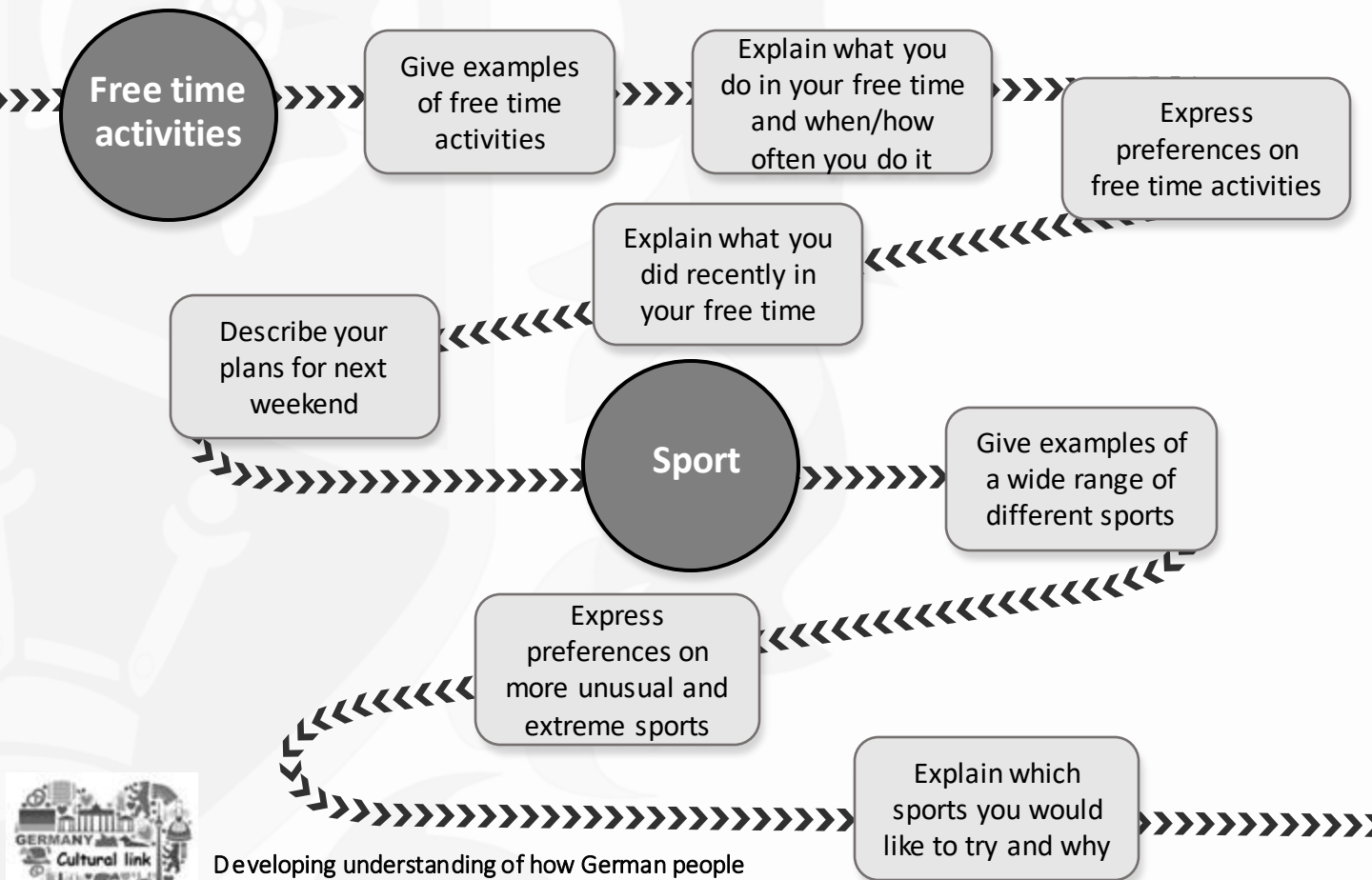


LEARNING JOURNEY DEUTSCH

This unit of work offers you the opportunity to refine and develop your proficiency when using key grammar fundamentals (e.g. the three main tenses, expressing preferences and the time-manner-place rule) all within the context within the familiar topic of free time. In Year 7 you covered the basics of this topic, but over the course of the half term, you will broaden your range of vocabulary and structures to refer to leisure activities. Additionally, towards the start of Year 9, you studied the topic of sport within the context of healthy living. Within this unit of work, you will further extend this knowledge by looking at more unusual and extreme sports. You will also start to express which sports you would like to try, as an introduction to the conditional tense. This enhanced understanding of both grammatical structures and core vocabulary, will serve you well in Year 10, within the topic of free time and technology.
