
LEARNING SPANISH **JOURNEY**

Year 7 Summer Term



Tiempo Libre: Free Time

During the Summer Term, you will retrieve knowledge of forming opinions from the Spring Term, when used to talk about school. You will have another opportunity to practise justifying opinions with reasons, whilst broadening your vocabulary knowledge of new adjectives. You will learn how to say what you do and when you do it, by diversifying your vocabulary knowledge of time phrases and weather conditions. You will have multiple opportunities to deliberately practise your speaking skills, retrieving how to form questions in Spanish, building on your roleplay skills nurtured in the Spring Term. You will practise the present tense by looking at places in the town, saying where you normally go. You will then build on this by learning how to form the future tense to say what you are going to do.



TUDOR HABITS:

Being a nalytical: Talking about the weather in Spanish is a tricky concept as it literally translates to 'it makes cold' or 'it makes sun'. Students will recognise that this is a tricky concept for native English speakers and will be open to feedback on in the event of any verbal miscommunications..
