

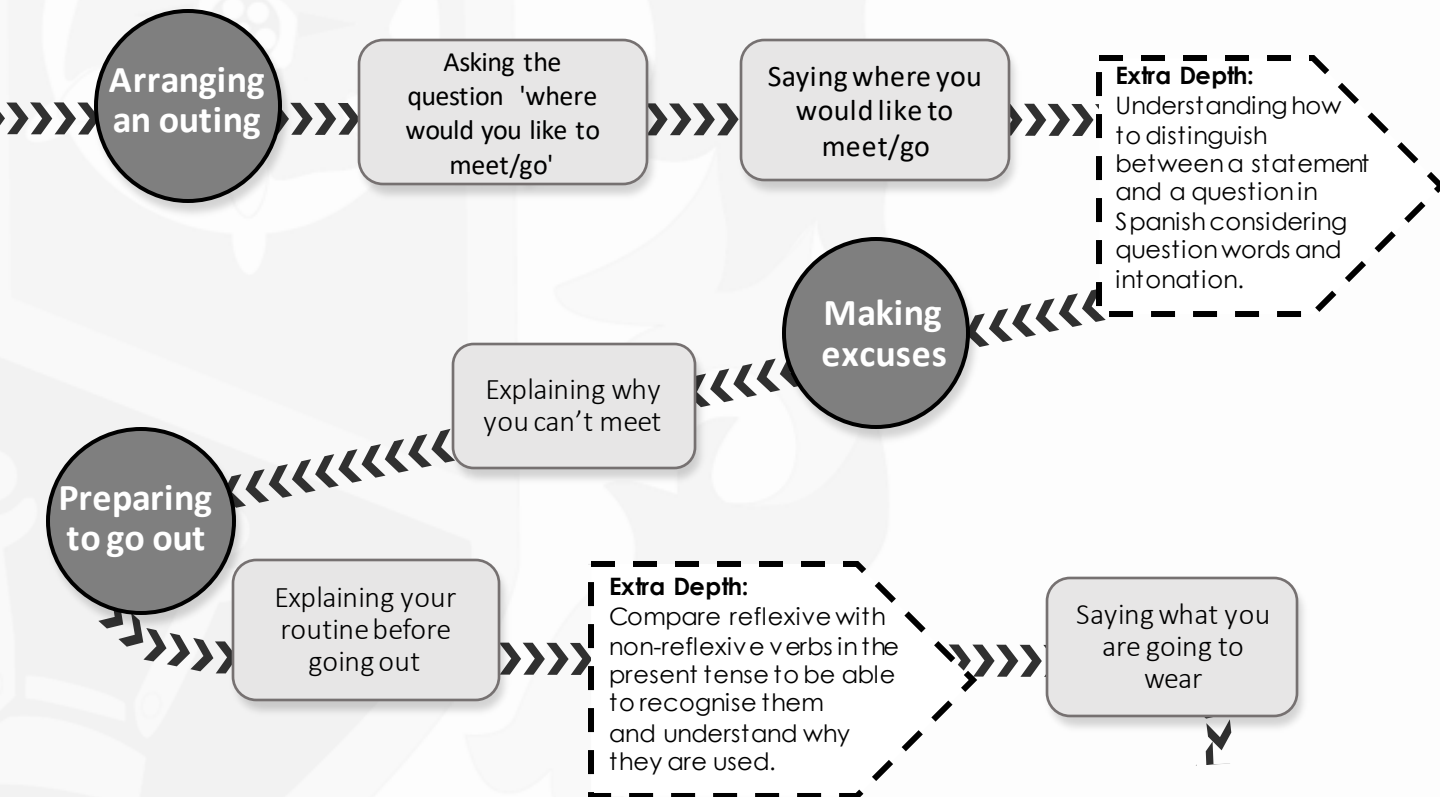
LEARNING SPANISH JOURNEY

¿Quedamos? (Arranging an outing with friends)

In the Summer term, you will consolidate your knowledge of how to form the present and conditional tenses, when describing where you would like to go out, why you can't go out and communicating what you're going to wear. You will have multiple opportunities for deliberate practice of present and conditional tenses and negative phrases in scenario-based conversations on arranging an outing and giving excuses. You will retrieve knowledge of the Town topic when arranging to meet a friend at different places in the town. You will be introduced to the grammatical concept of reflexive verbs when describing your pre-going-out routine.



TUDOR HABITS:

Be systematic when applying grammar rules for reflexive and non-reflexive present and conditional tense verbs. Engage with metacognitive strategies to successfully engage in scenario-based conversations on arranging an outing.

TIER 1 SPANISH VOCABULARY:

Me gustaría (I would like); puedo (I can/can I); me visto (I get dressed)

TIER 2 GRAMMATICAL TERMINOLOGY

Conditional tense (future tense to say what you 'would' do); reflexive verbs (daily routine verbs that reflect actions that are done to oneself)
