

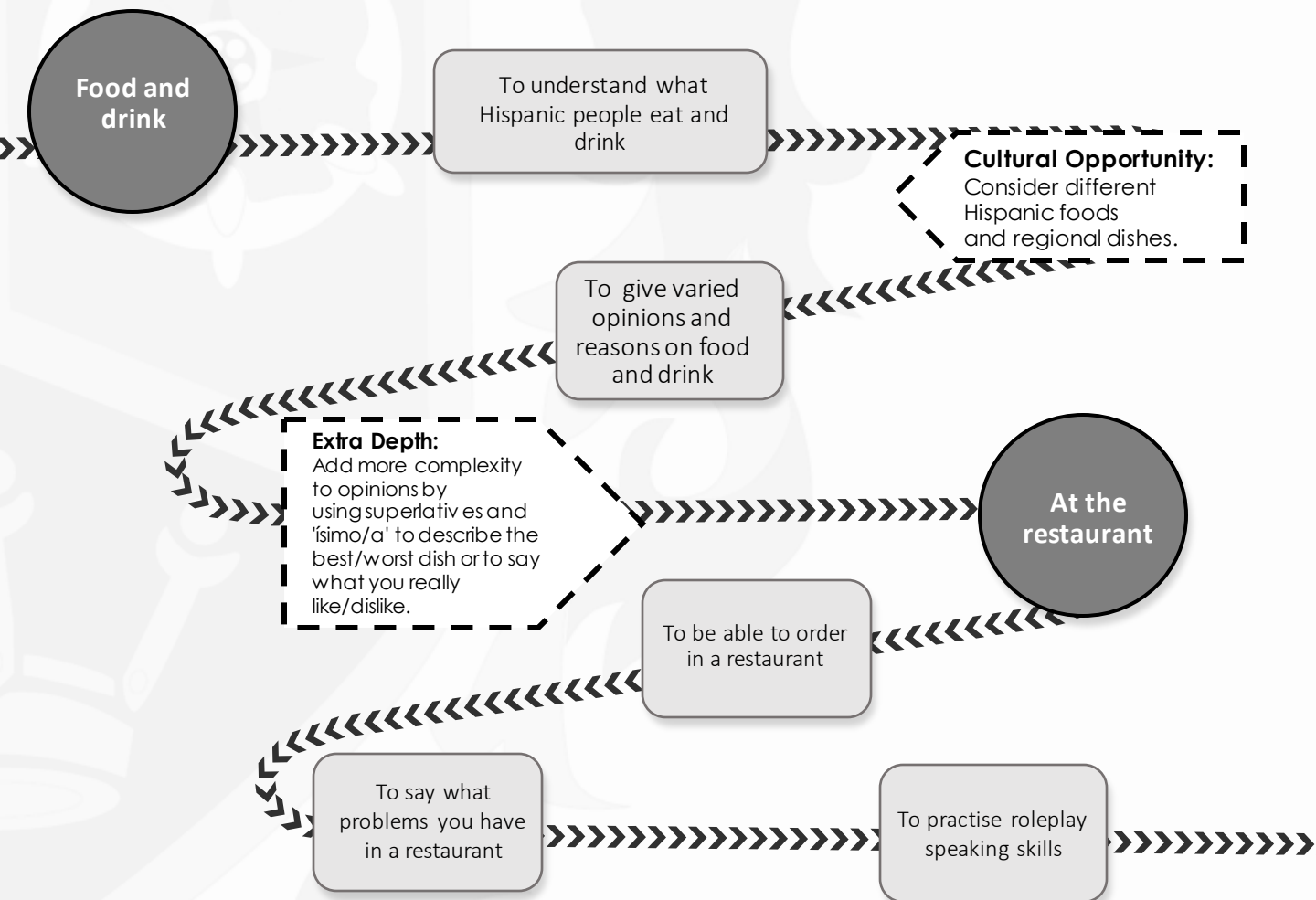

You will also look at the new grammar concept of adding ...'ísimo' to an adjective to make a superlative and work on GCSE roleplay skills.
