

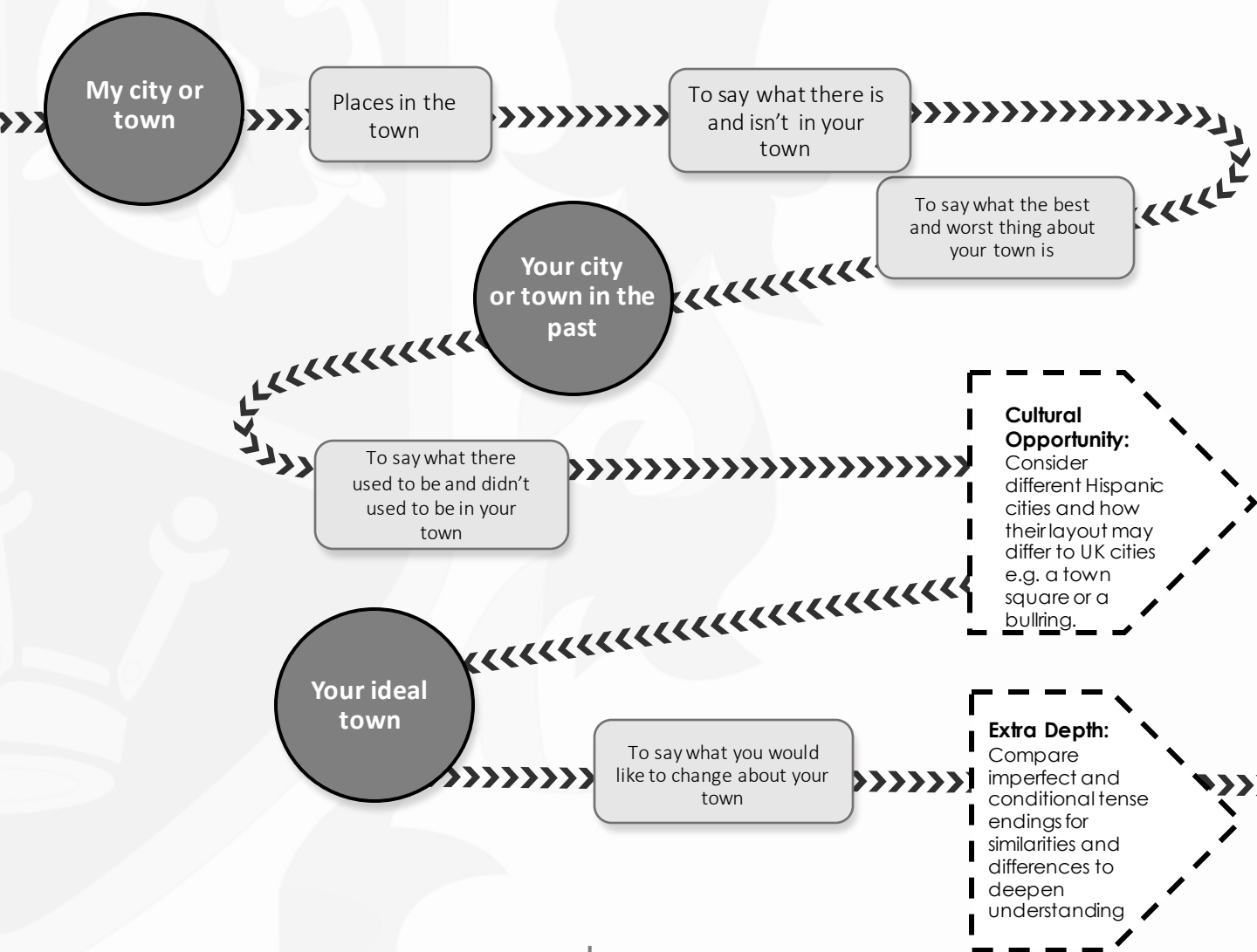

La Ciudad (Town) Year 9 Spring 1

In Spring 1, you will learn **vocabulary** for different **places in the town**, some of which will be retrieved from the topic of holidays in year 8. You will build on this vocabulary with a firm grasp of grammatical knowledge of the **present tense**, in particular the **irregular, core verb 'there is/are'** - a transferable verb across other topics. You will then learn how to give **complex opinions** using the **superlative** to say what the best and worst thing is in your town. You will **produce detailed descriptions of your town** through **spoken and written language**. You will **contrast** these descriptions by talking in the **past imperfect tense**. This grammatical knowledge will allow you to **compare what your town is like now with what it used to be like**. You will then retrieve your knowledge of how to form the **future tense** from years 7 and 8 by giving **recommendations** on how you would like to **change and improve your town**.

VOCABULARY:

TIER 1 SPANISH VOCABULARY:

Era (it was/used to be); tenía (it had/used to have); había (there was/were/used to be); estaba (it was/used to be) (location)

TIER 2 GRAMMATICAL TERMINOLOGY

Imperfect tense – a past tense used to describe what things 'used to be like'.
