

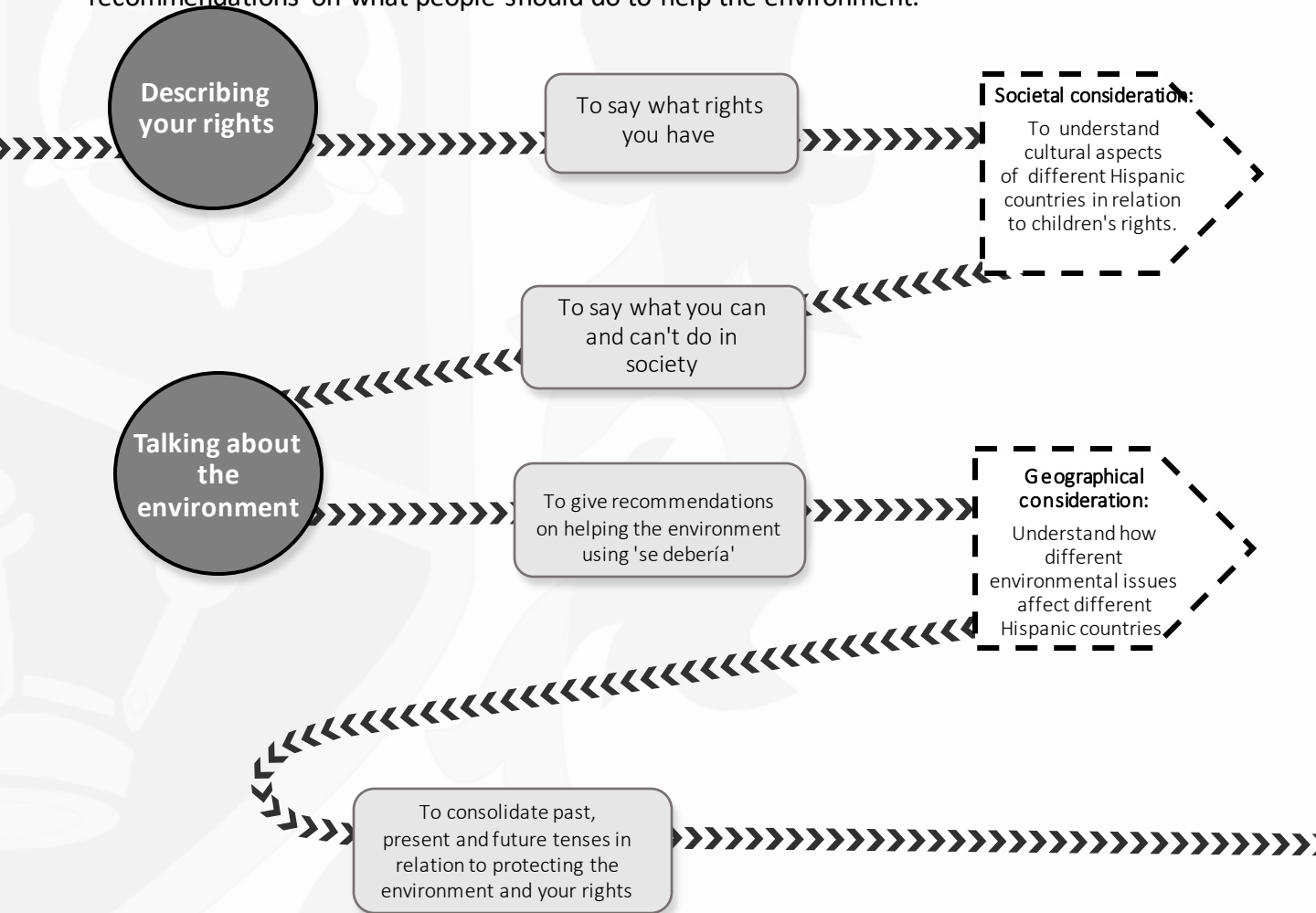

Year 9 Spring 2

In Spring 2, you will learn how to describe the rights that you have and what you can and can't do in society. You will demonstrate curiosity when evaluating how children's rights may vary across Hispanic countries. You will consolidate knowledge of modal verbs (you must, you can and you should), retrieved from year 8 summer term, to give recommendations on how to improve your environmental habits. As well as modal verbs, you will deepen your understanding of the future conditional tense and using infinitives, 'se debería + infinitive', to give recommendations on what people should do to help the environment.
